

# Overview of eBridge

This guide presents an introduction to eBridge. It is aimed to help students find their way around eBridge, access online course content, submit assignments, as well as locate useful information about various college departments.

eBridge is the College’s virtual learning environment (VLE). You can find here lots of useful information and learning materials to help you with your studies.

For example, your teachers can share online resources and other interactive content to support and extend your lessons in the classrooms. You can test your learning by completing online quizzes, watch instructional videos, and of course, submit your coursework online. You can also take part in online discussions with your teachers and other students. You can even contact your teachers by sending them messages.

## 1. Logging in and out



You must **SIGN-IN** to eBridge using Google Apps.

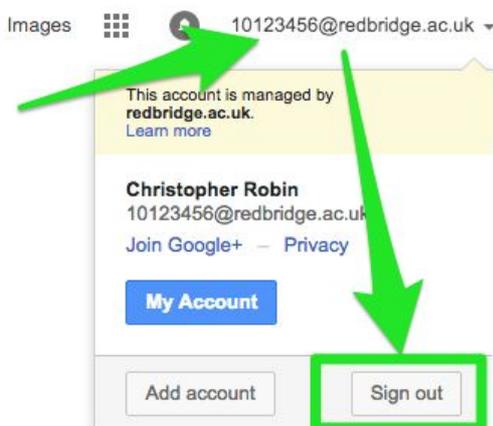
Click **Log in** on the top-right corner of any page.

Then, click  enter your username and password.

**Reminder:** Your username is your college email address (e.g. 10123456@redbridge.ac.uk).

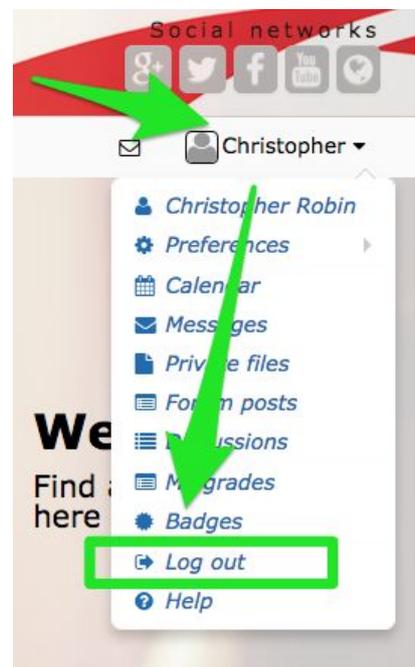
To **SIGN-OUT** from eBridge, click on your name on the top-right of any page and select **Log out**.

**If you are using a shared computer, iPad or Surface RT,** you need to **SIGN-OUT from Google** as well.

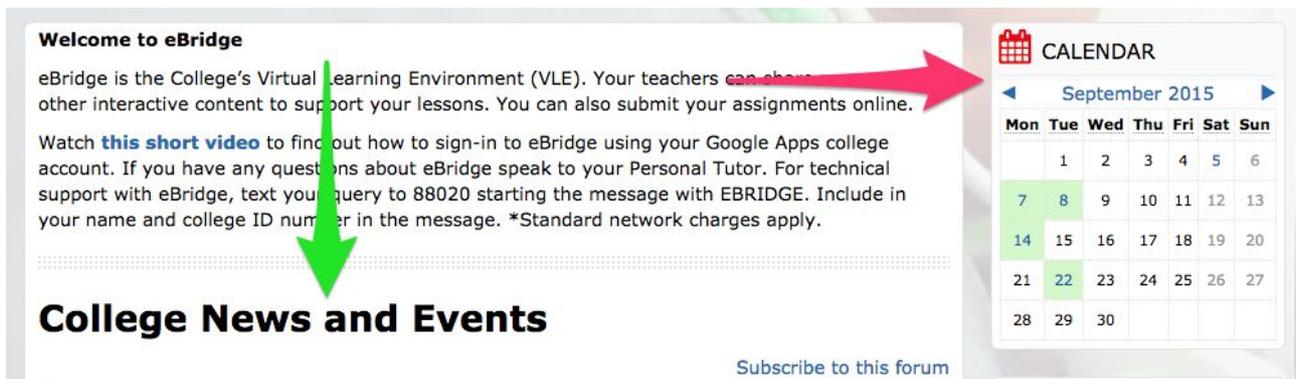


Open [www.google.co.uk](http://www.google.co.uk) (or click the **Google Drive** link under the Apps menu).

Then, click on your ID at the top-right of the page and finally click on **Sign out**.



## 2. Front page



Here you can find the latest college news, for example what are today's specials in Rouge restaurant, this week's enrichment programme, reminders of upcoming college events and competitions, etc. **Check out the news regularly so you won't miss out.**

On the front page (as well on other pages) you can view your **calendar**. It shows the main college events, such as term dates, study days, open evenings, etc. The calendar also shows the deadlines of your assignments and other course-related events and dates. You can export the calendar to your computer, tablet or smartphone.

## 3. Quick links menu

At the top of **every page** you can access the quick links that is loaded with quick access menus for finding easily what you are looking for on eBridge.

Below are the main categories of what you can access using the quick links menu.
